Boat Maryland - A Course on Responsible Boating

Maryland law requires anyone born on or after July 1, 1972 to obtain an approved boating safety education certificate and to carry this certificate whenever operating a vessel on State waters that is equipped with primary or secondary mechanical/electrical propulsion. **Effective October 1, 2010**, anyone under 16 must possess a Certificate of Boating Safety Education to operate a vessel equipped with primary or secondary mechanical/electrical propulsion unless they are being supervised by someone 18 or older who has a Certificate or its equivalent.

Flotilla 23-1 (<http://AnnapolisCGAux.org>) is offering the Boat Maryland Course for boaters of all ages in the Taylor Avenue Fire House (620 Taylor Ave) upper deck training room. Attendees will receive a MD "Certificate of Boating Safety Education" on successful completion of this course.

Flotilla 23-1 instructors are certified by the U.S. Coast Guard and MD Department of Natural Resources (MD DNR). They are experts on boating safety, seamanship and related topics.
